**RENEWAL OF PRACTISING
CERTIFICATES FOR YEAR 2012**

TAKE NOTICE that all Legal Practitioners are required to submit their application for practising certificates not later than November 30, 2011. Applications received after November 30, 2011 will attract a penalty fee of 20% of the subscription fee due. Applications received after December 31, 2011 shall not be processed. The following should be adhered to:

- a. Declaration forms should be completed in full; giving physical and postal addresses, telephone/facsimile numbers, mobile numbers and email addresses of the firms or advocates.
- b. Payments should be made as follows:

State Counsel	K5, 750,000.00
15 years and above	K5, 050,000.00
10-14 years	K4, 600,000.00
5-9 years	K4, 150,000.00
1-4 years	K3, 750,000.00

- c. Declaration Forms should be accompanied by payment and two passport size photos for identity cards.
- d. Unless exempted, every application should be accompanied by an Accountant's Certificate issued by a qualified Accountant in terms of the provisions of the Legal Practitioners Act and Curriculum Vitae for the file.

Applications should be submitted as follows:

1. For North Western, Luapula, Northern and Copperbelt Provinces to the Honorary Secretary, Mr. Samuel Twumasi of Kitwe Chambers, Plot 495/6, Permanent House, City Square, P.O. Box 21745, Kitwe.
2. The rest of the other provinces to the Honorary Secretary, Mrs. Nicola Ann Sharpe-Phiri of Messrs Sharpe & Howard Legal Practitioners, Plot No.8235, Nangwenya Road, P.O. Box 32587, Lusaka.
